

The RoHS (Restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances) directive 011/65/EU (before 2002/95/EG, RoHS I) of the European Union regulates the restriction and use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.

RoHS directive 2011/65 / EU, RoHS II was changed in June 2015 by directive 2015/863 / EU (RoHS III) and extended by 4 more substances.

List of restricted substances and their tolerated maximum concentration value, sorted by weight in homogeneous materials:

- 0,1 % Lead (Pb)
- 0,01 % Cadmium (Cd)
- 0,1 % Hexavalent Chromium (CR VI)
- 0,1 % Polybrominated Biphenyl (PBB)
- 0,1 % Polybrominated Diphenyl Ether (PBDE)
- 0,1 % Mercury (Hg)
- 0,1 % Di(2-ethylhexyl)phthalate (DEHP)
- 0,1 % Butylbenzylphthalate (BBP)
- 0,1 % Dibutylphthalate (DBP)
- 0,1 % Diisobutylphthalate (DIBP)
